

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF VILLAGE ROAD, MILTON ABBAS

DORSET COUNCIL has issued a Notice under Section 14 [2] of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 as amended. All vehicles will be prohibited from proceeding along Village Road, Milton Abbas from the junction with Catherines Well to the junction with King Edwards Drive (in both directions) a distance of approximately 460 metres. The Notice is needed in order to comply with health and safety regulations which require the provision of safe working areas and to minimise likelihood of danger to highway users. It will come in to operation on 1st June 2021 and can remain in force for up to 5 days, however it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 4th June 2021.

This Notice will enable Milton Abbey School safe access to carry out urgent works to remove 7 dangerous trees.

The alternative vehicular route, which will be sign posted is indicated by the blue line on the map below.
