I came across this saying by Dietrich Bonhoeffer last week in The Church Times, which I had not come across before. I wish I had heard it before.

JESUS YES - RELIGION NO!

That seems to me to sum up what Jesus taught in the gospels. He spent a lot of his ministry disagreeing with the religious leaders at the time. They were more concerned with the rules, than with people.

We all know that much religion of all varieties these days leads to argument, division & hatred.

If only we could have Jesus without all the clutter that goes with church life.

Jesus is concerned more with LOVE than Laws

I think we need laws, the important thing is they must be kept up to date but some are outdated. But that is not easy. Politicians are frequently telling us that some existing outdated laws do not permit something that is obviously the right way forward.

The suggested law on Assisted Dying is an example. The important thing is that we get it right. Parliament will spend a lot of time to make sure. They must not give in to those who make most noise - & perhaps even the majority.

We have not got the balanced right. We must have laws, human beings do get up to awful things.

Religions love rules! (The C of E is by no means exempt!) Jesus came to set us free, not to do whatever we like. But we do need to make it clear that certain activities are not acceptable to the state, let alone God. JJHB
