### 3. Hear the word of our Lord: Mark

The Gospel readings for 2024 come mainly from the book of Mark. Mark's Gospel stresses the deeds, strength, and determination of Jesus in overcoming evil forces and defying the power of imperial Rome. Mark also emphasises the Passion, predicting it as early as chapter 8 and devoting the final third of his Gospel (11–16) to the last week of Jesus' life.

During Lent, we will repeating last year's reading of the Gospel in one session, much as the early Christians would have done. It will take place in the Old School Room, Winterborne Whitechurch on Saturday 24<sup>th</sup> February at 11.00am. Lunch will be provided and we aim to finish by 2pm at the latest. Generally believed to be the first Gospel written, it is the shortest, being only 16 chapters.
